Academic Session, 2023-24



Continuing with our constant drive towards betterment ,the academic year started with the resolutions and commitments to provide an excellent teaching and learning platform to all the students. The teaching staff reported back in the institute on 02/08/2023 after summer vacations while the classes started from 07/08/2023. The academic year started with a meeting in which probable lacunae in the functioning of the institute, be it academics, hostel , mess ,or extracurricular activities and suggestions to fill the gaps in functioning were invited from the staff members for the betterment of the institute. The Principal emphasized on the three fold strategy for the academic year 2023-24

- **1. ADMISSION** We aimed at fairly good number of admissions to the different branches running in our institute. A core committee was formed that looked into the admission process. Its functions ranging from visits to the local intermediate schools to the use of social media for bringing into light the branches running in our institute and prospects of enrolling under these diploma programmes.
- **2.CHILD CENTERED APPROACH** It was emphasized by The Principal that once a girl gets admission to GGP Almora it is the duty of the teachers ,who are also mentors to these students, to adjust and tailor the activities according to each child's unique academic or psychological needs. Emphasis was laid on imparting sound practical knowledge to the students.
- **3. PLACEMENT** Being a technical institute that is adorned with the state of the art laboratories, equipments and above all ,highly experienced, dedicated and dynamic staff, the placement cell was assigned with the most important task to approach maximum number of reputed companies for 'on campus placements'. We aim at achieving 100% placement of our students.

SESSION 2023-24

We had 75 admissions in first year and 06 in lateral entry this year which is quite good a number for us. The students were given options of either staying in college hostels or staying off campus. We were happy to find that 50 out of 75 students opted for hostels, most of the non hostellers being residents of Almora.
